LISBON BY DESIGN

An intimate crafts & design event in Lisbon 24 – 28 May 2023

LISBON by DESIGN returns to Palacete Gomes Freire for a third edition packed with outstanding artists, artisans, studios and galleries that take craftsmanship and design to a whole new level. Unique pieces, created exclusively for LISBON by DESIGN, will be on display for five days (24 – 28 May) at the fair — courtesy of 19 participants who devote their craft to superior quality and contemporary prominence.

This year, LISBON by DESIGN will take place alongside a new and exciting event created in partnership with From My City, a creative placemaking agency: the first edition of Lisbon Design Week, an extension of LISBON by DESIGN around Portuguese creativity and objects made in Portugal with a diversified programme including a range of events put together by about 50 participants.

LISBON by DESIGN will also be in the off program of ARCOlisboa 2023, the renowned international contemporary art fair, which will take place simultaneously in Lisbon.



THE THIRD EDITION

The third edition of LISBON by DESIGN takes place in the intimate setting of Palacete Gomes Freire, in the heart of Lisbon, but it will also extend to a unique, unprecedented event in Lisbon, the first edition of Lisbon Design Week. The initiative, put forth by LISBON by DESIGN founder, Julie de Halleux, and From My City founder, Michèle Fajtmann, is an opportunity to spread the spirit of the fair within the city.

In Julie's words, "This year, I wanted to follow the same line as the previous editions and show renowned artists and newcomers, both with pieces and installations conceived specially for the fair. But the most important thing is to transform LISBON by DESIGN into a platform where creatives and the industry can meet and connect. And what we're doing with Lisbon Design Week is exactly that."



THE STORY OF LISBON by DESIGN

After a few years of researching and getting acquainted with Portugal-based artists and artisans, Julie de Halleux took her curiosity and fascination further and decided to showcase high-end, unique pieces created with superior materials that explore the most exciting techniques. Her love for interior design, a world she's already stepped into countless times, also played a substantial role in launching LISBON by DESIGN.

The setting was something of utter importance to Julie, and Palacete Gomes Freire, a 19th-century charming haven in Lisbon, was the perfect location from day one. "I wanted people to see the art pieces in a private palace that could be your house. A big house, nonetheless, but still a house", she says. She adds: "I wanted to do something that didn't exist. I wanted to gather the best makers that I liked in Portugal, and I wanted to show them in a beautiful scenography, like no one had done before while keeping it simple and elegant, something that elevated craftspeople with a high-quality approach."

Soon, she wanted to become more independent and started investing in real estate while developing, at the same time, a practice of home interiors consulting, both for her own and for clients' projects. Some of her realisations were published in various decoration and lifestyle magazines. After ten successful years in Brussels, she moved in 2013 with her family to Lisbon, where she was attracted by the beauty of the city and the investment opportunities in the real estate market. While developing her real estate projects, she started to explore the wealth of talented artists and artisans in Portugal. She rapidly concluded that they deserved to be better promoted. That led her to launch the Lisbon by Design intimate design fair, which first and second editions, in 2021 and 2022, were a great success. Julie strives to develop this fair and launch new initiatives around Portuguese artists and artisans.
